

EMS Captain:

- Oversees EMS operations, including training, protocols and equipment.
- Supervises EMTs and paramedics, ensuring compliance with medical standards.
- Manages EMS-related reporting, quality assurance, and data tracking.
- Works closely with medical directors and regulatory agencies.
- Responds to high-acuity medical calls and provides on-scene leadership.

Fire Operations Captain:

- Oversees fire suppression, training, and response operations.
- Ensures apparatus, equipment, and gear are maintained and compliant.
- Conducts fireground leadership, safety enforcement, and strategy development.
- Manages fire-related reporting and incident analysis.
- Coordinates with mutual aid partners for fire response efficiency.

Staffing & Shift Structure

- **Shift:** 48 hours on / 96 hours off
- **Rotation:** Captains alternate shifts to provide continuous leadership.
- **Crew Assignments:** Each captain supervises the on-duty personnel during their shift.

Qualified applicants can expect a pay range of between \$52,000 and \$78,000 per year.
